



RESPONDING O CRISIS

In March 2021 the City of White Salmon declared a climate crisis. The declaration recognizes that from our city to our planet, we are facing an unprecedented change in global temperature. Our changing climate is causing increasingly damaging effects on our forests, health, economies, and livelihoods.
