City Council of White Salmon held a Workshop with leaders of Forth Share Non-Profit Company and OptConnect Company regarding E/V Charging Stations being installed in White Salmon.

Workshop began at 5:02pm.

Forth Share submitted a grant on behalf of the Cities of Bingen and White Salmon to provide a dual port E/V Car charging station in each city. One port will be used for a shared car provided by the grant and the second port will provide an opportunity for individuals to pay to charge their personal electric vehicle.

Stefanie Griggs from Forth explained the details of the Forth Grant Program.

Amy Hillman from OptConnect presented the details regarding the installation of the grant funded station and also provided information to the council of the potential to add an additional charging station. She presented the opportunity as a way for the city to purchase a 2nd station at a discounted rate and discounted labor since the contractors will already be installing the grant station.
