## CITY OF WHITE SALMON ORDINANCE NO. 2013-04-914

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON REVISING WSMC CHAPTER 8.08 TO ADD SECTION 8.08.135 PERMITTING SPECIAL LARGE CONTAINER RENTAL RATE FOR NONPROFIT YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, the City of White Salmon provides refuse collection services to the residents of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council finds that in certain instances the \$25 per month large container (1 yard and more) monthly rental rate imposes a hardship on nonprofit organizations that provide youth activities for area youth; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council finds that the current rates do not allow an adjustment to refuse collection charges where youth programs are adversely impacted by large container rental charges.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1 – Adding a new section 8.08.135:** 

**PASSED** in regular session this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 2013.

WSMC **8.08.135** <u>Rates and Charges – Large Container Rental Rate Reduction for Nonprofit Youth Programs Authorized.</u>

The Public Works Director is authorized in his or her discretion to reduce or waive large container rental charges upon application of nonprofit organizations that provide activities or educational opportunities for area youths.

**SECTION 3 - SEVERABILITY:** If any section, sentence, or phrase of this Chapter is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence or phrase of this Chapter.

**SECTION 4 - EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective following passage and publication as provided by law.
