

**ORDINANCE NO. 2013-06-917**

**AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE POOL TEMPORARY CHANGE FUND OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON.**

WHEREAS, the amount of change needed to operate the pool has increased due to the 2013 pool fee schedule.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON DO HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

**Section 1.** WSMC 3.24.200 is hereby amended as follows:



3.24.200 Swimming Pool Reserve Fund, Petty Cash and Pool and City Hall Change Fund

A fund to be known as the "Swimming Pool Reserve Fund" is created. The interest accrued in the Swimming Pool Reserve Fund shall remain in the respective fund. There shall be a Petty Cash Fund at City Hall in the amount of twenty-five dollars. From the month of June through August, there shall be a temporary Change Fund at the Swimming Pool in the amount of ~~twenty-five~~ fifty dollars or as otherwise approved by Council Resolution. There shall also be established a Change Fund at City Hall in the amount of one hundred fifty dollars per drawer with the number or drawers to be set by Resolution. The city Clerk/Treasurer is authorized to make such transfers and budget revisions to reflect the interest of the city council as contained in this section.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
