ORDINANCE NO. 2014-08-946**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON REVISING WSMC CHAPTER 8.07 NUISANCES AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of White Salmon has adopted WSMC 8.08 Garbage Service Required which includes penalties for failure to maintain garbage service; and

**WHEREAS**, the City intends to implement the garbage service requirements as part of its Garbage Service Required Code, WSMC Chapter 8.08, rather than as part of the Nuisance Code, WSMC 8.07.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of White Salmon does hereby ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** Items ~~stricken through~~ are removed and items underlined are added.

**Section 2.** White Salmon Municipal Code 8.07.030 (F)(a) as follows is adopted.


- F. To permit any portion of any premises to become or continue to be in a state which causes an unsafe condition, offensive odors, or unsanitary conditions, including, without limitation;
- a. To fail to maintain regular garbage collection service with the authorized holder of a valid solid waste collection certificate from the Washington State Utilities and Transportation Commission, according to the rules and rates established by said provider shall constitute a nuisance but the City may alternatively enforce this requirement under WSMC 8.08 Garbage Service Required;

**Section 3.** White Salmon Municipal Code 8.07.045 Abatement of Failure to Maintain Garbage Service is repealed in its entirety.


**Section 4- SEVERABILITY.** If any section, sentence, or phrase of this Chapter is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence or phrase of this Chapter.

**Section 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall become effective following passage and publication as provided by law.


