ORDINANCE NO. 2014-10-951**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON,  
ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMIT FOR DOCK GRADE ROAD, AMENDING  
PENALTIES FOR SPEED VIOLATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY  
AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS,** the City finds that establishing speed limits on Dock Grade Road is necessary for vehicle safety; and

**WHEREAS,** the City may establish speed limits for city roads within its city limits, and

**WHEREAS,** the City wishes to tie speed violation penalties to state speed penalties.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the City Council of the City of White Salmon do ordain as follows:

**Section 1. Establishing a new Section WSMC 10.08.100 Dock Grade Road – Penalty for Violation**

**10.08.100 Dock Grade Road —Penalty for violation.**

- A. The speed limit on Dock Grade Road shall be thirty (30) miles per hour from its intersection with SR 14 to the left hand bend in the road prior to the residential area;
- B. The speed limit on Dock Grade Road shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour from the beginning of the left hand turn prior to the residential area to its intersection with SR 141.

**Section 2. Amending penalty sections of speed limit ordinances:**

**10.08.010 State Route 14 and 141 speed limits-Penalty for violation.**

- A. There shall be and are established the following speed limits, which shall be applicable to the areas within the corporate limits on the city, as hereinbelow specified:
  - 1. From the west city limits upon State Route No. 14 to the east city limits on State Route No. 14, the speed limit shall be designated as forty (40) miles per hour;
  - 2. From the east city limits, on State Route No. 141, to Sixth Avenue, the speed limit shall be designated as thirty-five (35) miles per hour;
  - 3. From Sixth Avenue to M.P. 1.64, .03 miles north of the junction of Garfield Street on State Route No. 141, the speed limit shall be designated as twenty-five (25) miles per hour.
  - 4. On State Route No. 141 beginning at M.P. 1.64, .03 miles north of junction of Garfield Street and running within the city limits to M.P. 3.09 fifty feet north of Peck Road encompassing 1.42 miles of the ~~newly established~~ pedestrian walkway the speed limit shall be designated as thirty-five (35) miles per hour.
  - 5. The ~~schematic~~ diagram attached to the ordinance codified in this section is

incorporated by reference.

~~B. Any violation of such speed limits shall constitute a traffic infraction, and shall be punishable as established by RCW 46.61.400 and the monetary schedule promulgated by Washington State and adopted by the City of White Salmon.—~~

**10.08.020 Rhineland-Rhinegarden Park-Speed limits.**

A speed limit shall be imposed on operators of all vehicles of any nature, kind or description, including motorcycles, not to exceed fifteen (15) miles per hour on all perimeter streets surrounding Rhineland-Rhinegarden Park, namely North Main Street on the east side thereof, Northwest Washington Street on the north side thereof, Northwest Garfield Street on the west side thereof, and Northwest Lincoln Street on the south side thereof.

**10.08.030 Rhineland Park Signs required. Public Works Director Signing Authority.**

~~The city is authorized to install speed restrictive signs accordingly. The City Public Works Director is authorized and directed to place signage on City rights-of-way for the speed limits established in this Chapter WSMC 10.08 consistent with the Model Uniform Traffic Control Device requirements for speed signage.~~

**10.08.040 Rhineland Park Penalty for violation. Penalties for Violation.**

~~Any violation of Sections 10.08.020 and 10.08.030 shall be punishable by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars for each offense. Any violation of the basic rule set forth in RCW 46.61.400(1) or of a speed limit established in this WSMC Ch. 10.08 shall constitute a traffic infraction, and shall be punishable as according to the monetary penalties established in 46.63.110 which is incorporated herein by this reference.~~

**10.08.050 Waubish Street—Penalty for violation.**

A. There is imposed a speed limit of fifteen (15) miles per hour on Waubish Street for its entire length.

~~B. The public works director is directed to have speed limit signs placed on Wabish Street in conformance with this section.—~~

**10.08.060 N.E. Center Street—Penalty for violation.**

A. The speed limit on N.E. Center Street, from the intersection of Orchard Street to the intersection with O'Keefe Street shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour when children are present and otherwise shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

~~B.—The public works director is authorized and directed to post appropriate signs consistent with the provisions of this section.—~~

~~C.—Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be deemed to have committed a traffic infraction and shall be penalized in an amount not to exceed fifty dollars.—~~

**10.08.070 N.E. Tohomish Street—Penalty for violation.**

A. The speed limit on N.E. Tohomish Street, from the intersection of Orchard Street to the intersection with O'Keefe Street shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour when children are present and otherwise shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

~~B.—The public works superintendent is authorized and directed to post appropriate signs consistent with the provisions of this section.—~~

~~C. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be deemed to have committed a traffic infraction and shall be penalized in an amount not to exceed fifty dollars.~~

**10.08.080 O'Keefe Street—Penalty for violation.**

A. The speed limit on O'Keefe Street, beginning at the intersection with N.E. Tohomish Street to the intersection of N.E. Center Street shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour when children are present present and otherwise shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

~~B. The public works superintendent is authorized and directed to post appropriate signs consistent with the provisions of this section.~~

~~C. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be deemed to have committed a traffic infraction and shall be penalized in an amount not to exceed fifty dollars.~~

**10.08.090 Lincoln Street—Penalty for violation.**

A. The speed limit on Lincoln Street shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour from Garfield Street west to the city limits.


~~B. The public works director shall have speed limit signs placed on Lincoln Street, nonconformance with this section.~~

~~C. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be deemed to have committed a traffic violation and shall be penalized in an amount not to exceed fifty dollars.~~

**Section 3. Severability.** If any section, sentence, or phrase of this Chapter is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence or phrase of this Chapter.


**Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective following passage and publication as provided by law.
