

**CITY OF WHITE SALMON
ORDINANCE NO. 2014-11-955**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON,
ESTABLISHING ONE-WAY DESIGNATION FOR TOHOMISH STREET AND
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City finds that establishing a one-way designation on Tohomish Street between Church St. and Main St. is necessary for vehicle safety; and

WHEREAS, the City may establish one-way directions for city roads within its city limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of White Salmon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Amending Tohomish Street to require one-way designation:

10.08.070 N.E. Tohomish Street.


A. The speed limit on N.E. Tohomish Street, from the intersection of Orchard Street to the intersection with O'Keefe Street shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour when children are present and otherwise shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

B. Traffic between Church Street and Main Street shall be one-way from West to East.


Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, or phrase of this Chapter is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence or phrase of this Chapter.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective following passage and publication as provided by law.

PASSED in regular session this 19th day of November, 2014.


