ORDINANCE NO. 2015-05-970

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WA, AMENDING CHAPTER 13.16.025 (H) OF THE WHITE SALMON MUNICIPAL CODE, ADJUSTING MISCELLANEOUS SERVICE CHARGES AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, WSMC Ch.13.16.025 (H) establishes miscellaneous service charges for water users of White Salmon public utilities both inside and outside city limits; and

WHEREAS, the City has incurred additional costs in closing out and setting up new utility accounts to ensure accurate final meter readings and transfer of responsibility;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of White Salmon deems it to be in the best interest of the City that the miscellaneous service charges be combined and clarified;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: by the City Council of the City of White Salmon that the following amendments be made to White Salmon Municipal Code Chapter 13.16.025 (H):

SECTION 1 – Amendment to WSMC 13.16.025 (H)

Section 13.16.025 (H) is hereby amended to read:

13.16.025 Monthly water fees.


No late charge or delinquent fee shall be charged against any municipal corporation or political subdivision of the state.

SECTION 2 - SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, or phrase of this Chapter is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity

or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence or phrase of this Chapter.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective following passage and publication as provided by law.
