

**CITY OF WHITE SALMON WASHINGTON
ORDINANCE NO. 2017-06-1009**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING WSMC SECTIONS 10.24.170 and 10.24.180
REGARDING BACK-IN PARKING AND ADDING NEW WSMC SECTION 10.24.170
MAXIMUM LENGTH PARKING ON JEWETT BOULEVARD AND PROVIDING FOR
SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, business leaders have spoken out against the City's recent code section requiring back-in parking on Jewett Boulevard;

WHEREAS, the City of White Salmon has reviewed the code regarding back-on parking on Jewett Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the City feels that the changes to the code are necessary to accommodate the concerns of the business community after over a year with the change to back-in parking.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of White Salmon do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2016-06-984, § 1, 6-1-2016 and Ordinance No. 2016-08-988, § 1, 8-4-2016 (WSMC 10.24.170 and WSMC 10.24.180) are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 10.24.170 is hereby replaced with the following:


Beginning at the south east corner of the intersection of East Jewett Boulevard and 1st Street travelling east along the south side of East Jewett Boulevard until the mid-block point of the 200 block of East Jewett Boulevard, parking is prohibited for vehicles and trailers exceeding twenty (20) feet in length as indicated by marked pavement lines.

SECTION 3- SEVERABILITY: If any section, sentence, or phrase of this Chapter is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence or phrase of this Chapter.


SECTION 4 - EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective following passage and publication as provided by law.


