

RESOLUTION 2013-03-361

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON, DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON.

WHEREAS, the City of White Salmon is the owner of certain property described below; and,

WHEREAS, said property is of no benefit to the City of White Salmon; and,

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the City of White Salmon if said property could be sold; and

WHEREAS, the City of White Salmon desires to designate any items not sold in surplus may be sold by any other commercially reasonable method; and,

WHEREAS, listed items not sold or otherwise disposed of shall be donated to an appropriate recipient or otherwise to Washington Gorge Action Program.


