CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 2013-03-364

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A VACTOR TRUCK FROM THE CITY OF HOOD RIVER, OREGON, AND WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENT DUE TO SPECIAL MARKET CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that based upon the condition of the current Vactor truck there is a need to purchase a replacement truck; and

WHEREAS, RCW 39.04.280 provides that a local agency, by Resolution, may waive the competitive bidding requirement when the purchase is clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supply, or when the purchase involves special facilities or market conditions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the City of Hood River, Oregon is positioned to sell their surplussed Vactor truck in the amount of \$50,000, which is below market value, due to their policy of selling surplus equipment to other government entities at half the fair market value of the equipment to support other government entities, and that there is a special market condition because the City will receive the lowest price that is offered by any other agency or dealer; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it appropriate to waive the competitive bidding requirements for the above reasons; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:

- 1. The City's purchase of a Vactor truck from the City of Hood River, Oregon in the amount of \$50,000 (including tax and licensing fees), and
- 2. The competitive bidding requirement for the Vactor truck is waived as this purchase involves special market conditions.
