A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON REPEALING RESOLUTION 201302-359 AND APPROVING INCLUSION OF THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON INTO THE PROPOSED EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE DISTRICT


WHEREAS, council of the City of White Salmon approved Resolution 2013-02-359 approving inclusion of the city limits of the City of White Salmon into the proposed Emergency Medical Services District as long as the rate is not more than \$.24 per thousand of assessed value; and

WHEREAS, the projected financial statements for the proposed district show the need for a levy rate of \$.29 per thousand of assessed value, which is lower than the current rate of \$.34 per thousand of assessed value for the EMS in Hospital District #2; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of White Salmon will have a chance to vote on the levy rate for the proposed Emergency Medical Services District.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the City of White Salmon hereby repeals Resolution 2013-02-359 in its entirety and approves the inclusion of the city limits of the City of White Salmon into the proposed Emergency Medical Services District.
