

**RESOLUTION 2015-11-426**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON, DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON, WASHINGTON.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of White Salmon is the owner of certain property described below; and,

**WHEREAS**, said property was destroyed in a fire and is of no benefit to the City of White Salmon; and,

**WHEREAS**, it would be in the best interest of the City of White Salmon if said property could be sold; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of White Salmon desires to designate any items not sold in surplus may be sold by any other commercially reasonable method; and,

**WHEREAS**, listed items not sold or otherwise disposed of shall be donated to an appropriate recipient or otherwise to Washington Gorge Action Program.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE PROPERTY LISTED BELOW BE DECLARED SURPLUS PROPERTY:**

Section 1. The following items are to be surplused and sold through a bidding process effective as of the November 4<sup>th</sup> regular Council meeting as approved by motion:

Section 2. The City of White Salmon authorizes those useable items to be surplused and sold through a bidding process or any other commercially reasonable method.
