

**RESOLUTION 2018-05-469**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITE SALMON,  
WASHINGTON, DECLARING A PUBLIC WORKS EMERGENCY RELATED TO THE  
WHITE SALMON POOL**

**WHEREAS**, on April 30, 2018, the City of White Salmon public works staff began inspections and work on the White Salmon Community Pool to ready the pool for the 2018 season; and


**WHEREAS**, upon inspection, the Public Works staff found that the upper interior surface of the swimming pool mechanical room has significant concrete spalling with corrosion of reinforcing steel and other embedded metals which has resulted in the deterioration of the structure; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions found by Public Works are safety hazards to the employees and the public who use the pool; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to make repair the hazards to insure a safe environment for employees and the public and because the pool is scheduled to open June 2, 2018; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT I**, David Poucher, Mayor of White Salmon, as a result of the above-described situation, hereby declare that a State of Emergency exists related to the condition of the White Salmon pool and direct the City Administrator to hire a structural engineer to review the area in question to determine how repairs can be made to make the White Salmon Pool safe for employees and the public and further, to use day labor, or if necessary, hire a construction company to make such repairs.
