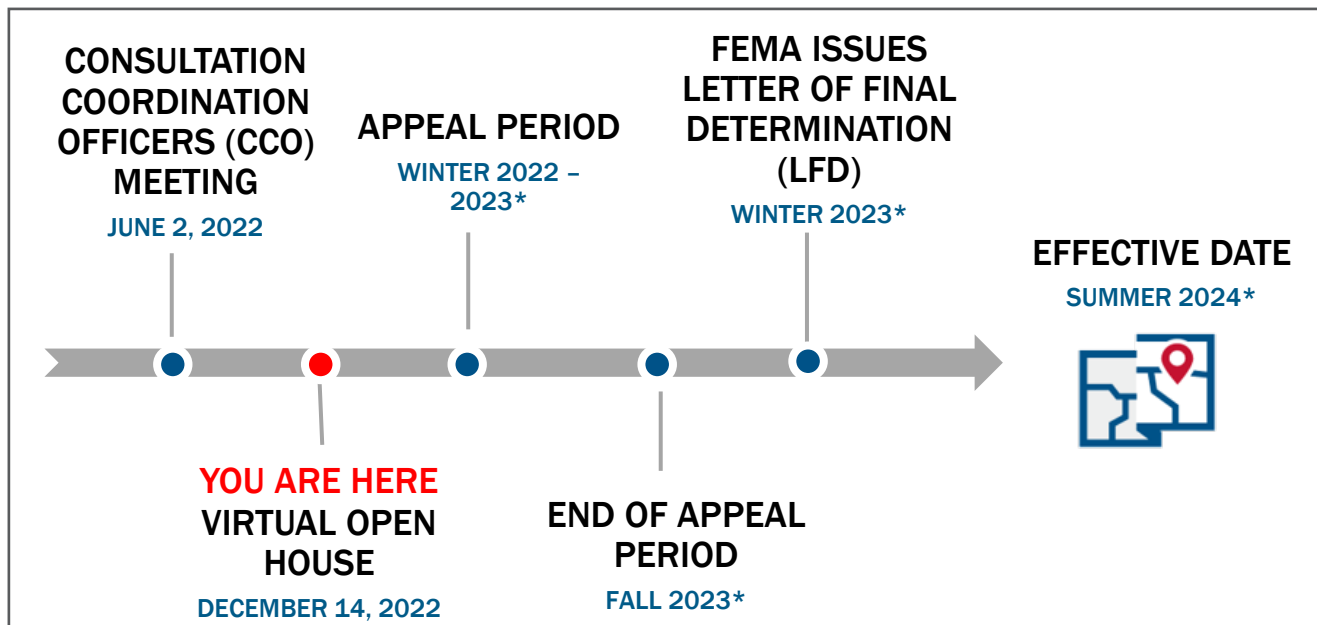
During this Virtual Open House, you can speak with an expert to learn more about your home's flood risk and what the updated map means for you. **There will not be a formal presentation during this virtual event.**
