For chickens, ducks and rabbits, all animals must be contained inside a secure enclosure with interior dimensions of not less than three square feet per animal, or larger area if required for the animals' or residents' health or safety, with not less than five feet of setback from dwellings.

Goats

Appeal Fee.....\$25
For goats, the tethering or fencing planned or in place needs to prevent damage to neighboring properties.

Lambs (4-H or FFA only)

Appeal Fee.....\$25
Allowed only for the months of March through August, provided the owner shows proof of participation in 4-H or FFA)

Don't forget to include:

- A copy of the spay/neuter certificate to be eligible for the spay/neuter rate
- A copy of 4-H or FFA enrollment (if applicable)

Additional information needed for Chickens, Ducks, Rabbits and/or Goats:

- Please explain any planned health care provisions for the animals.
- For goats, please explain why goat(s) are the preferable method for controlling brush and reducing fuel.
- Please draw your property below indicating the location where the animals will be maintained.
