REMOVAL TIMELINE

Begins at snowfall

Scope of Responsibilities / Priorities

- * Major Arterial roads
- * Collector roads



City Streets

REMOVAL TIMELINE

Three inches of snow has accumulated and/or case by case

Scope of Responsibilities

- * 16 miles of hard surface, including downtown sidewalks
- * 11 miles of rural roads

Priorities

- * Emergency Service Routes
- * Residential Streets
- * Downtown Parking/Sidewalks



RESIDENTS

Residential Sidewalks

REMOVAL TIMELINE

Recommended removal within 24 hours after snow stops

Scope of Responsibilities

- * Private road, alleys and driveway
- * Sidewalks in front of the home
- * Adjacent fire hydrants



Snow Facts

- * Average Snowfall: White Salmon receives an annual average of about 15 inches of snow.
- * Snowfall is most common from November through February.
- * It can range from a few inches to over a foot during significant snowstorms.
