

## SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Accepted curbside or self haul to any location. Curbside recycling is offered free to residents, call Republic Services to sign-up for service.



- **Mixed Paper**
  - o Larger than 3" only, window envelopes accepted
- **Cardboard & Paper Boxes**
- **Aluminum & Tin Cans**
  - o Lids larger than 3" or placed inside of the can
- **Plastic Bottles, Jugs, & Tubs**
  - o Lids larger than 3" or screwed onto the item

  - Automotive supplies, batteries, cleaners, fluorescent bulbs, pesticide, fertilizer, chemicals, propane.

## WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT

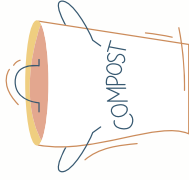

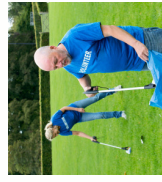
### Coming Soon, Pending Grant Approval

A special recycling program is being developed that will allow residents to drop off 3 specific materials: film/plastic bags, baling twine, and polystyrene. These materials are **not accepted** in the local recycling stream. There is a local market as long as the material is separated and low on contamination. We have applied for a grant through the WA Dept. of Ecology. If approved the program will begin in early 2022! We do need a business for drop-off locations on both the East side and West side of the County. If your business is interested please contact the Programs Coordinator at the Solid Waste Department.

Another program requested in that same grant is the development of and Environmental Education Program including hands-on kits that can be checked out. The goal being to empower residents through the education to be environmental advocates in all aspects of their lives.

### Litter Clean-Up-

Through a grant with the Washington Department of Ecology and the cooperation of Republic Services, Klickitat County Solid Waste provides litter and illegal dump clean-up throughout the county. We utilize volunteer crews to make this program possible. We are looking to expand our program.
